

Lolworth Village Show 2018 Rules

1. Unless otherwise stated all exhibits must be the property of the Exhibitor. All entries in the fruit and vegetable and flowers sections must have been grown in Lolworth by the Exhibitor who is resident in Lolworth at the date of the show. The only exceptions to this rule are in the case of item 32 (flower arrangement for dinner table) and item 33 (flower arrangement in a teacup) where flowers may be from any Lolworth garden.
2. Entries in the pantry and handicrafts sections must be the Exhibitor's own work and the Exhibitor must be a resident of Lolworth at the date of the show. Items under the handicrafts section must not have been previously exhibited.
3. The open section is open to any Exhibitor not only residents of Lolworth. The children's section is open only to children under the age of sixteen at the date of the show who are resident in Lolworth at that date or are the grandchildren of someone who is resident in Lolworth at that date.
4. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any exhibit and in that event, is not required to give any reason or explanation. Any exhibit which does not conform to the wording of the sections schedule shall be disqualified and the entry card marked accordingly.
5. Where the number or quantity of plants, flowers, fruit, vegetables or pantry items is specified in the sections schedule for a class, any exhibit with more or fewer than the specified amount will be disqualified.
6. Exhibitors are not allowed more than one entry in any one class.
7. A charge of 20 pence will apply to each entry in each class. Entries in the Children's Section are free.
8. Any exhibits in the pantry section which are baked must be covered and accompanied by a list of ingredients for the purpose of identifying potential allergy problems.
9. Exhibitors must provide their own plates, vases, jars etc as required. The show committee will not be responsible for any breakages or loss.
10. The decision of the judges including matters not covered by these rules shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. All exhibits must be staged between 8 am and 10 am on the morning of the show. The marquee will be cleared of exhibitors by 10.15 am. No exhibit or part thereof may be altered or removed until 4pm. The show committee will be grateful for any exhibits that can be used in the Ploughman's Supper.
12. Entry forms together with payment in cash of the appropriate entry fees **must** be submitted to arrive by midnight on 5th September 2018. Entry forms must be submitted by mail or by hand to *venue to be confirmed*.
- 13 Each Exhibitor will be issued with a class certificate for each entry prior to the show and will be required to complete the details and submit it with the entry.
- 14 The winner of each cup is required to insure and engrave it. Cups should be returned to John Houlton during the third week of July 2019.
- 15 Photographs may be taken at the show and unless you have notified John Houlton to the contrary you consent to the use of any photograph in which you appear for Lolworth village publicity purposes
