## **CITY DEAL UPDATE**

There will be a new travel app which will begin next month in city only. SCDC app will follow. The app has been developed by the University and is very cheap. It will be able to inform users of the position of the bus they aspire to catch, but could be extended to provide information concerning floods, clean air and the vermin control.

Rural travel hubs. This project will link our largest villages directly to the city by bus. Kirsty Human has been appointed project officer for the scheme and has begun with the project initiation document.

Greenways for cyclists. Cambridge is a hub and greenways are the spokes linking the large villages to the city. They will follow field edges where necessary. Links between the large villages will follow. £480,000 have been set aside for this scheme, three officers have been seconded for 2 years.

A popular café run by volunteers who specialise in repairing broken household items and clothes will be returning to Fulbourn on Saturday 13 May.

Fulbourn Repair Café is a social community event where local people can take their broken items to be fixed, free of charge, by a team of multi-skilled repairers.

Organised by Fulbourn Forum with the support of South Cambridgeshire District Council, Cambridge Carbon Footprint and Transition Cambridge, Fulbourn Repair Café aims to help tackle the rise of the throwaway culture by reducing the number of items going into the waste stream, saving people money and preserving traditional repair know-how and skills.

The café will take place from 2pm to 5pm in the Townley Hall at the Fulbourn Centre, Home End in Fulbourn.
