Both the **Greater Cambridge City Deal** [GCCD] **Assembly** and **Board** met this month. The Assembly made recommendations to the Board in relation to the allocation of funding/resource. Two proposals may have direct benefits for our villages. The first is to allocate £480K for a 2 year programme of work [2017-2019] to develop up to 12 cycling 'greenways' in South Cambridgeshire. The second is the allocation of £100K to carry out initial feasibility work on South Cambridgeshire Travel Hubs. Both were subsequently agreed at the GCCD Board meeting.
